# Case Study for Non-Ablative Treatment of Acne Scars

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Date: April 8, 2011

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## **Profile**

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#### Introduction:

34 year old Asian woman with Type III skin presented with moderate to severe acne and acne scarring. 5 years before laser treatments, she was treated with isotretinoin 1 mg/kg for 5 months, with general resolution of the acne breakouts.

#### Discussion:

Treatment plan was to utilize the Lux1540™ non-ablative fractional laser to improve acne scars.

### Treatment with StarLux<sup>®</sup> 500 System and Lux 1540™ Handpiece:

Treatment sessions:

1<sup>st</sup> treatment: 50 mJ/15 ms, 10 mm tip, 3 passes 2<sup>nd</sup> treatment 5 weeks later: 50 mJ/15 ms, 10 mm tip, 3 passes

3<sup>rd</sup> treatment 5 weeks later: 50 mJ/15 ms, 10 mm tip, 3 passes

4<sup>th</sup> treatment 5 weeks later: 50 mJ/15 ms, 10 mm tip, 3 passes

5<sup>th</sup> treatment 5 weeks later: 50 mJ/15 ms, 10 mm tip, 3 passes

6<sup>th</sup> treatment 6 weeks later: 50 mJ/15 ms, 10 mm tip, 4 passes

#### **Conclusion:**

Patient had some transient hyperpigmentation after each treatment which resolved with topical retinoid and 4% hydroquinone. Marked improvement of acne scars and skin texture after six treatments.
